RS, SCS & Food Safety Audits Guidelines for Walmart China Direct Import New Suppliers

Responsible Sourcing, Supply Chain Security, and Food Safety Compliance audits are mandatory requirements to become a qualified Walmart Direct Import supplier. Below are the main process to assist suppliers to understand and complete the new facility on-boarding process.

Responsible Sourcing (RS) & Supply Chain Security (SCS) Process

- 1. Review facility RS Disclosure Policy and disclose the facility, and SCS Disclosure Policy;
- 2. Disclose facility:
 - Fill in attached disclosure form as per disclosure policy required;



Disclosure For

- Send back the disclosure form with scan copy of the facility's business license or any of below equivalent document if business license is not applicable in the country/area where the facility locates.
 - ✓ Proof of tax filings; Food safety certificates; Utility bills (electricity or water bills); Water treatment certificates, etc.; or
 - \checkmark Any other government issued document that contains the name and address of the facility

3. Audit:

Responsible Sourcing (RS) Audit (Some Audit firms call it Social Compliance)

Provide ONE of below <u>Approved Audit Program</u> report conducted in last 12 months for review; if no, supplier or facility contact audit firm and choose one for audit;

Supply Chain Security (SCS) Audit

Complete ONE of below SCS audit options:

- Option 1: Obtain a Walmart SCS audit
- Option 2: Obtain a SCS audit from an Approved Third-party Program;
- Option 3: Demonstrate that it is <u>CTPAT Tier 2</u> or 3 certified, have an AEO accepted by Walmart or another Walmart accepted waiver;
- Option 4: Participate in the <u>Small Supplier</u>
 Program

Food Safety Audit Process

Walmart requires processing and / or co-packing facility must meet food safety audit requirement.

Category 1 Facility that hold GFSI-recognized certificate

One Action Needed:

Provide one of the following GFSI certificates

BRC, IFS, SQF GLOBAL GAP, FSSC 22000, China HACCP, GRMS, CANADA GAP, PRIMUS GFS, GAA (BAP), JFSM, Asia GAP (for more details, please visit www.myafsi.com)

Category 2 Facility that hold ISO 22000, HACCP certificate or food safety audit report based on GFSI global market program

Two Actions Needed:

1. Provide one of the following documents.

ISO 22000, HACCP certificate or food safety audit report based on GFSI global market program

2. Provide GFSI certification plan

Facility should proceed to obtain GFSI certificate within 12 months of the product award, GFSI certification plan should be filled in the attached form and the complete form should be provided

Category 3 Facility that does not have the above certificates or audit report **Two Actions Needed:**

- 1. Facility needs to undergo food safety audit based on GFSI global market program. For more details, please contact <u>Cindy.liu@Walmart.com</u>
- 2. Provide GFSI certification plan (same as above)
